By renewing its fleet with 300 electric vehicles, ANAVEO continues its efforts to limit its environmental footprint.

ANAVEO to gradually purchase 300 electric vehicles

ANAVEO is stepping up in 2023 by gradually providing its employees with electric vehicles. Already, about ten charging stations have been installed at the headquarters, and investments are underway to deploy them directly to the employees' homes.

The group's goal is to acquire 300 electric vehicles suitable for various uses, ranging from city cars to utility vehicles, over the next three years.
